

## **Data Collection Privacy Notice**

## What do we do with your report?

- Combine it with the information from other reports and make the combined, deidentified information available as vaccine safety data for the general public (<u>Victorian</u>
  <u>COVID-19 vaccine safety data</u>), immunisation policy makers, national vaccine
  surveillance networks and researchers of ethically approved related studies.
- Investigate any potential vaccine or immunisation system problems and notify the relevant government bodies.
- Forward reports to the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) who closely monitor and assess vaccine safety in Australia.
- For any significant adverse events, your information may be provided to a clinician who will check in with you and may provide further assistance.

We will not disclose personal information about you to anybody else, unless you have given consent, or we are authorised or required to do so by law.

Both the rapid and extended reports form part of the SAEFVIC clinical quality registry managed by MCRI. MCRI stores all personal information in secure environments and performs regular security testing of its systems.
