

Data Collection Privacy Notice

What do we do with your report?

- Combine it with the information from other sources including the Australian Immunisation Register, to assist in the identification of any possible vaccine safety signal or 'flag' for concern.
- Investigate any potential vaccine or immunisation system problems and notify the relevant government bodies.
- Forward reports to the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) who closely monitor and assess vaccine safety in Australia and provide de-identified information about adverse events and incidents related to therapeutic goods used in Australia (<u>DAEN</u>).
- Make the combined, de-identified information available as vaccine safety data for the general public, immunisation policy makers, national vaccine surveillance networks and researchers of ethically approved related studies.

For any significant adverse events/vaccine administration error, your information may be provided to a clinician for expert review. They may contact you for further information and follow up.

We will not disclose personal information about you to anybody else, unless you have given consent, or we are authorised or required to do so by law.

Reports form part of the SAEFVIC clinical quality registry managed by MCRI. MCRI stores all personal information in secure environments and performs regular security testing of its systems.
